Strasburg, Lancaster County, PA—Seats are now available on a first-come, first on board basis for the New England Ramble, a custom-designed, five-day, four-night trip with the Friends of the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania. This unique excursion is scheduled from October 13 through 17, 2010, during the height of the colorful fall foliage season in New England.

The autumn Ramble features five picturesque train rides in New Hampshire and Vermont—the Mount Washington Cog Railway, the Notch Train of the Conway Scenic Railroad, the Winnepesaukee Railroad, the Café Lafayette dinner train and the White River Flyer.

Additionally, travelers will visit the Pioneer Valley Railroad in Massachusetts and will enjoy a cruise on Lake Winnepesaukee, a tour of the historic Mount Washington hotel and lodging at the Mountain Club on Loon Resort & Spa.

The New England Ramble is an ideal way for individuals to enjoy time together and share their enthusiasm for trains and railroad history with friends, family members and colleagues. This trip also offers numerous delightful opportunities for “leaf peeping” in scenic fall settings.

The New England Ramble includes roundtrip motorcoach transportation from the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania; all admissions, trains and tours listed in the itinerary; four nights’ hotel accommodations; four breakfasts, five lunches and four dinners; baggage handling; driver and step-on guide gratuities and tour escort.
