

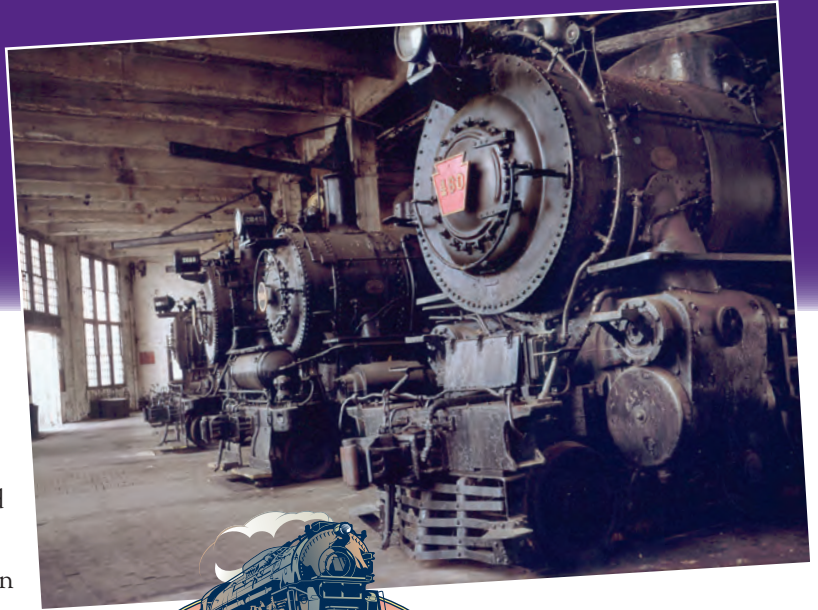

Due to the construction in the Museum parking lot, and limited parking at the Strasburg Rail Road on what is a Day Out With Thomas day, we are offering a complimentary shuttle service to our members and guests. A 25-passenger bus from Elite Coach will run every 15 minutes—according to the schedule below—between Hershey Farm Restaurant & Inn, on PA Route 896 just outside of Strasburg, and the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania.

Please park in the south and east side of the Hershey Farm parking lot, near the horse hitch and away from the restaurant. Look for the shuttle signs. Big Little Railroad is a circa 1948 CNJ promotional film which tracks a car of coal from mine to tidewater. The film examines the Ashley Planes, motive power, maintenance-of-way and all of the things needed to keep a railroad running. Total running time is about 28 minutes.

Renaissance of a Railroad is a Pennsylvania Railroad promotional film from the mid 1960s touting the PRR's efforts to diversify and invest in both physical plant and other ventures. Many of the items highlighted in this film are also highlighted in *Wreck of the Penn Central* as contributing factors to that railroad's bankruptcy. Total running time is about 30 minutes.

Both of these sound and color films from the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania's collection have been restored using some of the most advanced methods available.

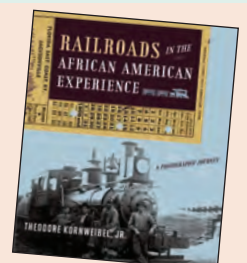

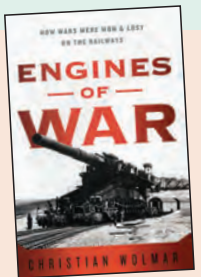

Join Mr. Christian Wolmar, Great Britain's foremost writer and broadcaster on transportation matters, for the dramatic story of how railways shaped the way wars were fought, won and lost, facilitating conflict on a previously unimaginable scale. The iron road not only made armies more mobile, but also greatly increased the scale and power of available weaponry. In doing so, wars were fought across wider fronts and over longer time periods, with far deadlier consequences. This presentation is based on Mr. Wolmar's most recent book *Engines of War*, which spans more than a century and takes in engagements in which railways played a part, including the Crimean War, American Civil War, both World Wars, the Korean War and even the Cold War.
