



Riding the Rails of America's Great Southwest

June 16 to 23, 2012

Join us for this memorable journey, featuring the culture, art, history, natural beauty and trains that define America's Great Southwest!



DAY 1. Albuquerque—Santa Fe. Transfers are included from central Pennsylvania for morning flights from Philadelphia International Airport to Albuquerque, New Mexico. In Albuquerque, we board our charter motorcoach and travel to the **Indian Pueblo Cultural Center**, dedicated to that native American society's culture, history and art. We'll take in the **Turquoise Trail**, a scenic byway, on our way to **Santa Fe**, where we'll spend three nights at the Hilton of Santa Fe in this exquisite city. Tonight's dinner is an authentic Southwest style meal at a local restaurant. (L, D)

DAY 2. Santa Fe—Santa Fe Southern Railway. Our **city tour** includes the Palace of Governors, St. Francis Cathedral and Loretto Chapel. Browse the International Folk Art Museum and stroll through the Indian Market. In the afternoon, we'll take a relaxing round trip ride on the charming **Santa Fe Southern Railway** to the scenic Galisteo Basin Overlook. Enjoy the rest of the day to explore Santa Fe. We spend a second overnight in Santa Fe. (B)

DAY 3. Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad. After an early breakfast, we travel north and board the **Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad**—once called the most awesomely spectacular example of mountain railroading in North America—in Antonito for our one-way ride to Chama. Arriving in **Chama**, we'll enjoy time at leisure to view the galleries or shop for local handicrafts before heading back to Santa Fe. The rest of the evening is yours to explore. We spend a third overnight in Santa Fe. (B, L)

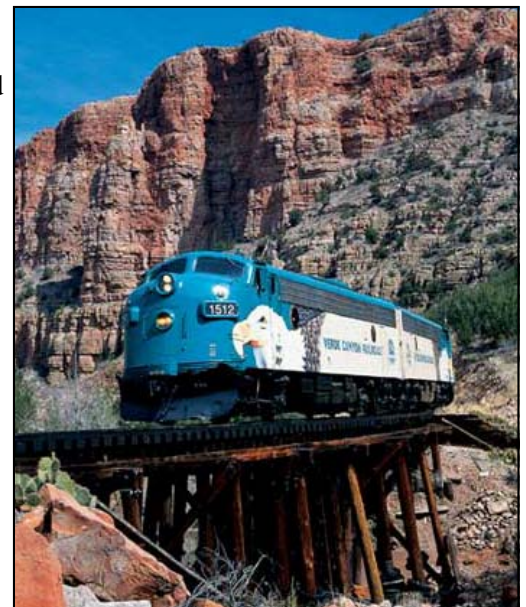
DAY 4. Santa Fe—Monument Valley. Bid farewell to Santa Fe as we travel through the rugged countryside to the **Four Corners** region, where you can stand in Utah, Colorado, New Mexico and Arizona at the same time. In the afternoon, we'll arrive at the "Eighth Wonder of the World" **Monument Valley** on the Navajo Indian Reservation. We'll check in at historic **Goulding's Lodge**, then experience an evening of Navajo culture, food and entertainment. (B, D)

DAY 5. Monument Valley—Grand Canyon. This morning, there's time to view the monoliths up close and personal and then enjoy lunch your own. Next, we'll depart for beautiful **Lake Powell** and enjoy a scenic cruise. Later, we'll travel to **Grand Canyon National Park** and learn about the amazing geology and history of the canyon, while taking in its breathtaking beauty. Tonight, we check into the Holiday Inn Express in Tusayan, Arizona, just outside the park. (B, D)

DAY 6. Grand Canyon Railroad—Sedona. In the morning, we'll have time for additional sightseeing in the park, followed by a train ride on the **Grand Canyon Railroad**, known for its service and restored railroad equipment as well as the scenery. After arriving in Williams, we'll board the motorcoach and head south to **Oak Creek Canyon's** red sandstone cliffs and towers. We check into the Best Western Arroyo Roble in beautiful **Sedona** for a two-night stay. (B)

DAY 7. Sedona—Verde Canyon Railroad. Today, we'll follow the red rock road through the amazing Conconino National Forest, then enjoy an exciting ride through the high desert aboard the **Verde Canyon Railroad's** fully restored vintage train. We spend a second overnight in Sedona and have an unforgettable farewell dinner. (B, D)

DAY 8. Phoenix—Philadelphia. Today, we say goodbye to the great Southwest, wonderful friends and a memorable journey as we transfer to the Phoenix airport for our flights to Philadelphia. (B)

- **INCLUDED FEATURES:** Roundtrip motorcoach transportation between central Pennsylvania and the departure airport, with gratuity to driver; roundtrip airfare from Philadelphia; 7 nights hotel accommodations; 7 breakfasts, 2 lunches and 4 dinners, with gratuities to wait staff; transportation on a luxury air-conditioned motorcoach; attraction admissions and train tickets as outlined in the itinerary; baggage handling at hotels; professional tour director; and AAA Travel escort.
