RAILROAD MUSEUM BASIC GUIDE

WELCOME to the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania,
a world-class museum of American railroad history
and the official railroad museum of the
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

- **ROLLING STOCK HALL & RESTORATION YARD:** The Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania's fascinating, premier collection of 115 historic locomotives and vintage railroad cars—made and/or operated in Pennsylvania—are on exhibit. Some pieces of equipment are open for inspection. The Restoration Yard may occasionally be closed to visitors due to inclement weather and/or other safety conditions. Check with staff at the Admissions Kiosk. **Restoration Yard Entrance: Platform 5 West.**
- **OBSERVATION BRIDGE:** View Rolling Stock Hall from above. **Access** the Observation Bridge from the **Second Floor Gallery** or by the **Stairs on Platform 5.**
- **STEINMAN STATION PASSENGER DEPOT:** Early 20th century passenger depot exhibit, with a waiting room, telegraph/ticket office and baggage room, where the Railroad Museum's **ORIENTATION VIDEO** is shown. **Platform 1 West.**
- **1915 STREET SCENE:** *Under construction.* A railroader's home and store front buildings, representative of a small town in Pennsylvania in the early 20th century. **Platform 1 West.**
- **STEWART JUNCTION RAILWAY EDUCATION CENTER:** Challenging, exciting and fun hands-on activities and programs for railroaders of all ages. **Platform 1 West.**
- **LOCOMOTIVE CAB SIMULATOR:** Hands-on, simulated train operation in an authentic Norfolk Southern freight locomotive cab. **Platform 5 East.**
- **RESTORATION SHOP:** Working vehicular preservation facility. To ensure your safety, the Restoration Shop is closed to visitors. However, a closed circuit tv screen allows you to view restoration activities as they are happening. Restoration Shop tours (*additional charge*) are offered at various times throughout the year and by advance group reservation. Check with staff at the Admissions Kiosk. **South End of Rolling Stock Hall.**
- **RAILROADERS' HALL:** Plaques commemorating the railroad service of hundreds of individuals. To honor a loved one or colleague with a Railroaders' Hall plaque, pick up a brochure in the Museum, call or visit the web site. **East Wall of Rolling Stock Hall.**
- **GALLERY:** Features the Grif Teller Studio exhibit, the Pennsylvania Railroad Board Room exhibit and changing exhibits throughout the year. **Second Floor.**
- **RESEARCH LIBRARY & ARCHIVES:** One of world's finest collections, with thousands of historic volumes and hundreds of thousands of photographic images and archival materials related to railroading. Contact the archivist in advance for an appointment. **Second Floor.**
- **WHISTLE STOP SHOP:** Museum store featuring a wonderful variety of unique and exclusive gifts, books, videos, prints, collectibles and wearables for the expert and the novice railroader. Store closes 15 minutes before the Museum closes. **Museum Lobby.**
- **RESTROOMS:** Hallway off the **Museum Lobby.**
- **WHEELCHAIRS:** Available on request from staff at the **Admissions Kiosk.**
- **BEVERAGE VENDING MACHINES:** **Platform 5 West**, next to the Restoration Yard entrance.
- **HOURS:** Monday through Saturday, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm; Sunday, 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm. Closed Mondays, November through March, and closed some major holidays.
