ITINERARY

5:30AM - Motorcoach will depart from Penn Cinema, located at 541 Airport Road, Lititz, PA 17543; travel to New York City with a rest stop en route. **Departure time is approximate and will be confirmed closer to date of travel.

After arriving at Penn Station's Moynihan Train Hall, explore the train hall and enjoy access to Amtrak's first class Metropolitan Lounge until it's time to depart. At 11:20am the NYC 43 is scheduled to depart for Albany-Rensselaer. After the train exits the tunnel in Manhattan, you'll experience a one-of-a-kind view of the Hudson River for almost the entire trip to Albany. Beverage service is available (non-alcoholic beverages only) as you enjoy passing scenery through what New York Central called their "magic windows". While traveling northbound, listen to narration of the historic route by an onboard docent and enjoy a buffet lunch.

You are scheduled to arrive in Albany at 1:50pm where the train will turn around in preparation for its journey south. Once the train is parked in the station, you'll be treated to an educational presentation by one of the onboard docents. While in Albany, you'll also have a great photo opportunity with the 20th Century Limited lounge car on the train's famous red carpet.

At 4:30pm, depart Albany and begin your southbound ride back to New York City. As you travel south you'll again enjoy the scenery of the Hudson River and have the opportunity to write a postcard on replica New York Central stationery and have it sent from the train, as passengers originally did on the New York Central. A catered buffet dinner will be served along the way. Return to Penn Station's Moynihan Train Hall at 7:05pm. After disembarking the train, re-board your motorcoach and travel back to Lititz with a rest stop enroute.
