Dedication of the historic *Rocket* **locomotive.** Presentation by **Museum Director Patrick C. Morrison** Museum Rolling Stock Hall.

In its first move in 90 years, the 185-year-old *Rocket* locomotive recently took off from the Franklin Institute in Philadelphia to its new permanent home at the Railroad Museum of

Pennsylvania. The *Rocket* was the first of eight English-made locomotives purchased by the Philadelphia & Reading Railway and is the only one that remains from that group.
