**Departure times are approximate and will be confirmed closer to date of travel.

Morning arrival at the Altoona Railroaders Memorial Museum for self guided tour. The Museum seeks to preserve the stories and contributions of Central Pennsylvanians who left an imprint on their communities, industry, and nation. You'll have three floors to explore where you will find an array of artifacts and immersive displays, including a rail yard and life size dioramas of railroad workers. This afternoon we'll climb aboard the Everett Railroad Company on a full steam-powered adventure. We'll travel 27 miles round trip between Holidaysburg and Martinsburg. Sit back and enjoy a delicious box lunch while taking in the fall breeze and breathtaking Autumn colors.

The day continues as we journey to Harrisburg for a private tour at the Harris Tower & Museum to experience the most authentic simulation of railroad tower activities in the United States. Followed by a private tour at the ex-Pennsylvania Railroad Power Directors Office at the Harrisburg, PA Amtrak station.

**Please keep in mind the ability to climb and descend several stairs is required to board the train and to explore the museums included on this itinerary. Participants need to be able to comfortably walk longer distances, and stand for extended periods of time.
