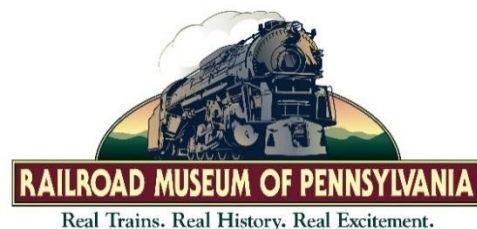
- **Kids railroad heritage craft activity table**, all day, in Rolling Stock Hall.
